



Statement of Recovery Resident Bill of Rights

As a member of this MASH Certified Sober Home you have rights that the residence staff will safeguard during your stay. You have a right to:

1. An environment that supports your recovery.
2. An environment that is safe and free from alcohol and other mood altering chemicals.
3. Be free from verbal and physical abuse.
4. Be treated with dignity and respect.
5. To be fully informed of expected recovery goals.
6. Be actively involved in achieving your recovery goals.
7. All good faith efforts to protect of your privacy and anonymity throughout your stay.
8. Have access, while living in the residence, to other community-based support services as needed.
9. Be referred to appropriate services upon leaving the residence if necessary.
10. Retain personal property that does not jeopardize your or others' safety or health.
11. File a complaint to the owner/operator or other oversight organization (e.g., MASH) without fear of retaliation and to have the complaint addressed within a reasonable amount of time.
12. Be fully informed before changes occur in these rights and responsibilities as well as to changes in policies and procedures should they occur.
13. Not to be required to perform services for the residence, which are not included in the usual expectations for all residents.
